

## TECH TIPS:

I want to point out a couple of things that might be helpful during your Virtual Field Trip:

1. If you intend to have your students navigate through the Field Trip independently, please ensure the content is viewable on a **student** School District device. If any of the embedded content is blocked by your school district, you will need to contact your IT Department and request that they “whitelist” or add [PowayOnStage.org](https://www.powayonstage.org) to their “safe domain list”.
2. If you lead the students through the Field Trip, please have them complete the “Show What You Know” independently. The link is on the **Teacher Resources page** listed above. It is an important part of our grant writing/reporting process. If you are not comfortable having students share their first name and school, please note that those fields are not required.
3. When viewing the videos, please note the control bar at the bottom:



You may be familiar with full screen mode (far right) but please note that there is an independent control for sound (the 5 bars), as well as chapters on the show episode videos. This is a great tool if you want to bypass the introduction or go straight back to the post-show discussion. Also, look here for Closed Captioning in English and Spanish.

4. If possible, please collect student work samples or photos to submit with your Teacher Survey! They are extremely helpful when telling our story to funders.
