AUDITION INFORMATION

Audition: Monday, March 4, 2024, 4-6pm

Where: Poway Center for the Performing Arts - 15498 Espola Road Poway, CA 92064

Audition and Week-Long Workshop are FREE -- Rehearsals Mon-Fri, March 4-8, 4:00-8:20pm

Performances: Saturday, March 9 at 3pm and 7pm at Poway Center for the Performing Arts

The Details:

You **must pre-register** for the audition by completing the online registration form. The deadline to register is **Friday, February 23, 2024**. Students in Kindergarten through 2nd grade will be selected to audition by a lottery process. Students in grades 3-12 will have an open audition. Lottery results will be announced on **Monday, February 26** via email. The audition will be held on Monday, March 4 at 4pm **SHARP** at the Poway Center for the Performing Arts. Parking is available in the lot behind the Theater on Titan Way.

There are roles for students in Kindergarten through 12th grade. Approximately 60 local students will be cast to appear in the show with the MCT Tour Actor/Director. **There is no guarantee that everyone who auditions will be cast in the play.** Students must arrive by the scheduled starting time and stay for the entire two-hour session. The first rehearsal begins 15-30 minutes after the audition.

This is a group audition - **no advance preparation is necessary**, just smile and have fun.

The Schedule:

Those auditioning must be available for ALL rehearsals for their role and for both performances on **Saturday, March 9**. You must have a clear schedule Monday through Friday 4:00-8:20pm and all-day Saturday. A detailed rehearsal schedule will be distributed at the audition's end. Cast members scheduled for the full 4½ hours of rehearsal will be asked to bring a sack dinner or snack. Typically, the youngest students (K-2nd grade) are not scheduled for the 6:20-8:20pm rehearsals.

Tickets can be purchased online at www.powayonstage.org. Seating for each show is General Admission. Cost is \$20 for Adults and \$10 for Youth (18 & under).
