




Jazzy Ash GRADES K-5

WORKSHOPS

Poway OnStage offers workshops to schools located within San Diego County. Our workshops are offered as an add-on component to our virtual programs or as a stand-alone program. Taught by local artists, these standards-based workshops are designed to provide creative opportunities, deepen understanding, and strengthen curriculum connections. Workshops are presented in partnership with Arts Education Connection San Diego and Southern California Ballet.



Latin Rhythms
September - October 2024
GRADES 1-6 (Duration: 50 minutes)
This fun and interactive workshop explores the rhythms of Latin America through a variety of percussion instruments, including conga and bongo drums, maracas, and guiros. Students will make their own music through body percussion and experimenting with different instruments.



Nutcracker - Stage to Classroom
December, 2024 - January, 2025
GRADES 1-6 (Duration: 60 minutes)
Taught by an expert ballet teacher,
students will learn basic ballet movements
and terminology, the history and
background of The Nutcracker story, and
simplified choreography from one of four
featured dances (The Party Scene, The
Battle Scene, The Snowflakes, and the Land
of the Sweets), Students will also be
shown various costumes and learn about
pointe shoes and pointe work.



African Rhythms
January - March, 2025

GRADES 1-8 (Duration: 50 minutes)

Bring the rhythms of Ghanaian culture to students through this engaging hands-on workshop.

Students will learn about traditional African percussion instruments such as djembe and kpanlogo drums and use their bodies and different instruments to create their own music.



Theater Workshops March 2025

GRADE 3 (Duration: 45 minutes)
Missoula Children's Theatre provides
a selection of theatrically based
enrichment workshops. Each workshop
is an educational and interactive
exploration of the performing arts
through hands-on activities taught
by MCT Tour Actors/Directors.
Examples of workshops include the
basic tools of an actor's trade and
teamwork through improvisation.



California Indian Storyteller November 2024 - April, 2025

Presented as an assembly, students will hear traditional stories and folk tales, learn about the history and culture of the Kumeyaay tribes within San Diego County, and interact with indigenous artifacts. Taught by a member of the Luiseño tribe, this engaging and educational presentation is a great accompaniment to students learning about California Indians and the Mission era



Alice in Wonderland April - May, 2025

GRADES 1-5 (Duration: 50 minutes)
Bring the stage to the classroom in this workshop by Southern California Ballet. In this exciting and engaging workshop, students will learn choreography from the ballet, including how choreography is created, and dive deeper into how to watch, enjoy and engage with dance on stage. Students will get a close up look at actual costumes from the show and learn about all the components that come together to create storytelling through dance.

Musical Theater Camp

Every year Poway OnStage brings the nationally recognized Missoula Children's Theatre to our community. For one week each March, Poway OnStage hosts over 60 children in a week- long "audition to production" Musical Theatre Experience on stage at the Poway Center for the Performing Arts. Intro to Instruments

Introduction to Instruments is an engaging and interactive educational assembly that introduces 4th graders to the different families of musical instruments and is designed to inspire students to choose an instrument and join the 5th grade band. During Introduction to Instruments, local high school band and orchestra students serve as mentors to students from 25 elementary schools in the Poway Unified School District. The program serves 2,600 4th graders with participation by over 200 high school band students.
